Salvation Army Casserole Recipe

Preheat oven to 400°

Ingredients:

Start with a 9" by 11" disposable aluminum pan greased or sprayed with PAM.

- 1 lb. sausage, browned/crumbled or
- ¾ lb. chopped ham
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 4 eggs
- 2 cups milk
- 1 cup Bisquick mix
- ½ tsp. pepper and salt to taste

Spread meat and cheese evenly on bottom of the pan. Combine eggs, milk, biscuit mix, salt and pepper in blender and blend one minute on high. Pour over meat and cheese. Bake 35-40 minutes (until firm in the middle), cool, cover with foil (spray with PAM) and freeze. PLEASE label the pan with the date and ham or sausage.
